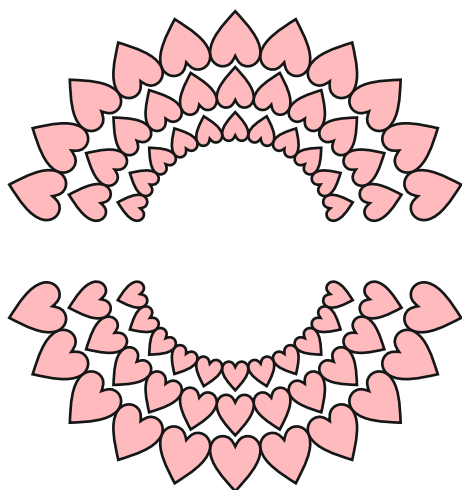


Free Quilt Design



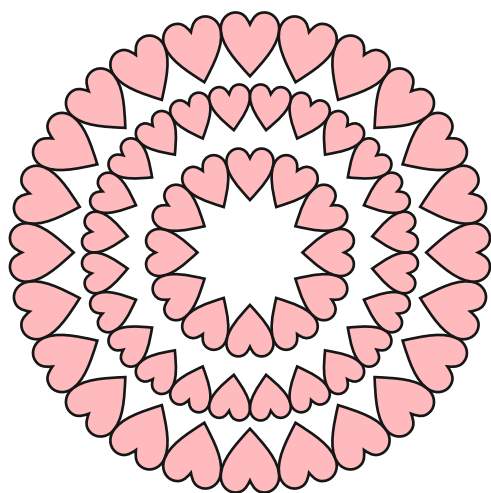
Design #1 - 12"

Print pages 2 to 5

If you want to use this design for a pouch, transfer it to a 14" x 14" piece of fabric. Quilt the piece, trim it to 13" x 13" and then assemble the pouch.

The center space in between the two pieces of the design is where you insert the zipper. Draw a 10" zipper opening; use a 10" zipper. Final size of pouch: 6" x 12".

This technique is explained in my ***Little Wonders*** pouch pattern.

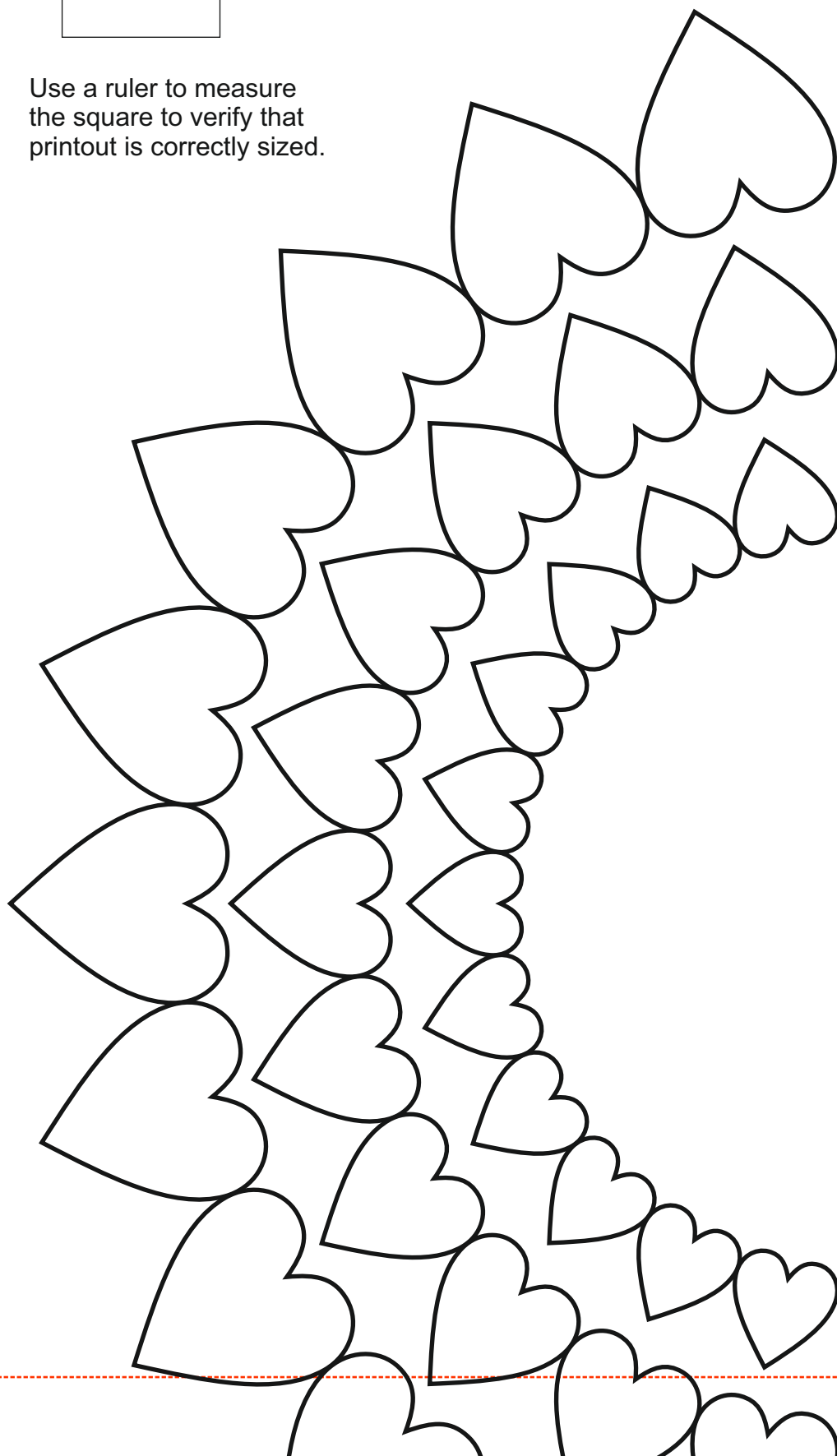

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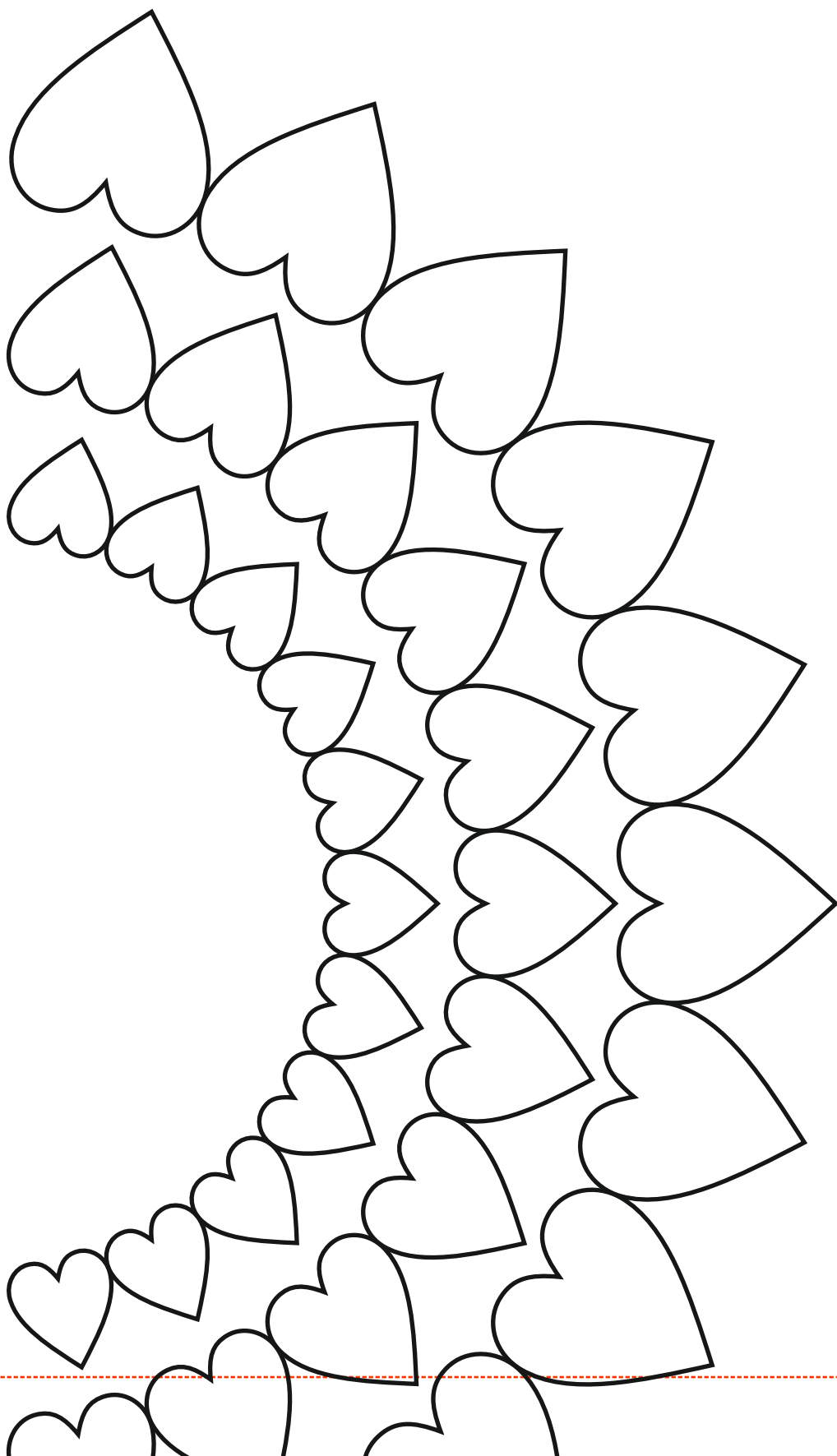

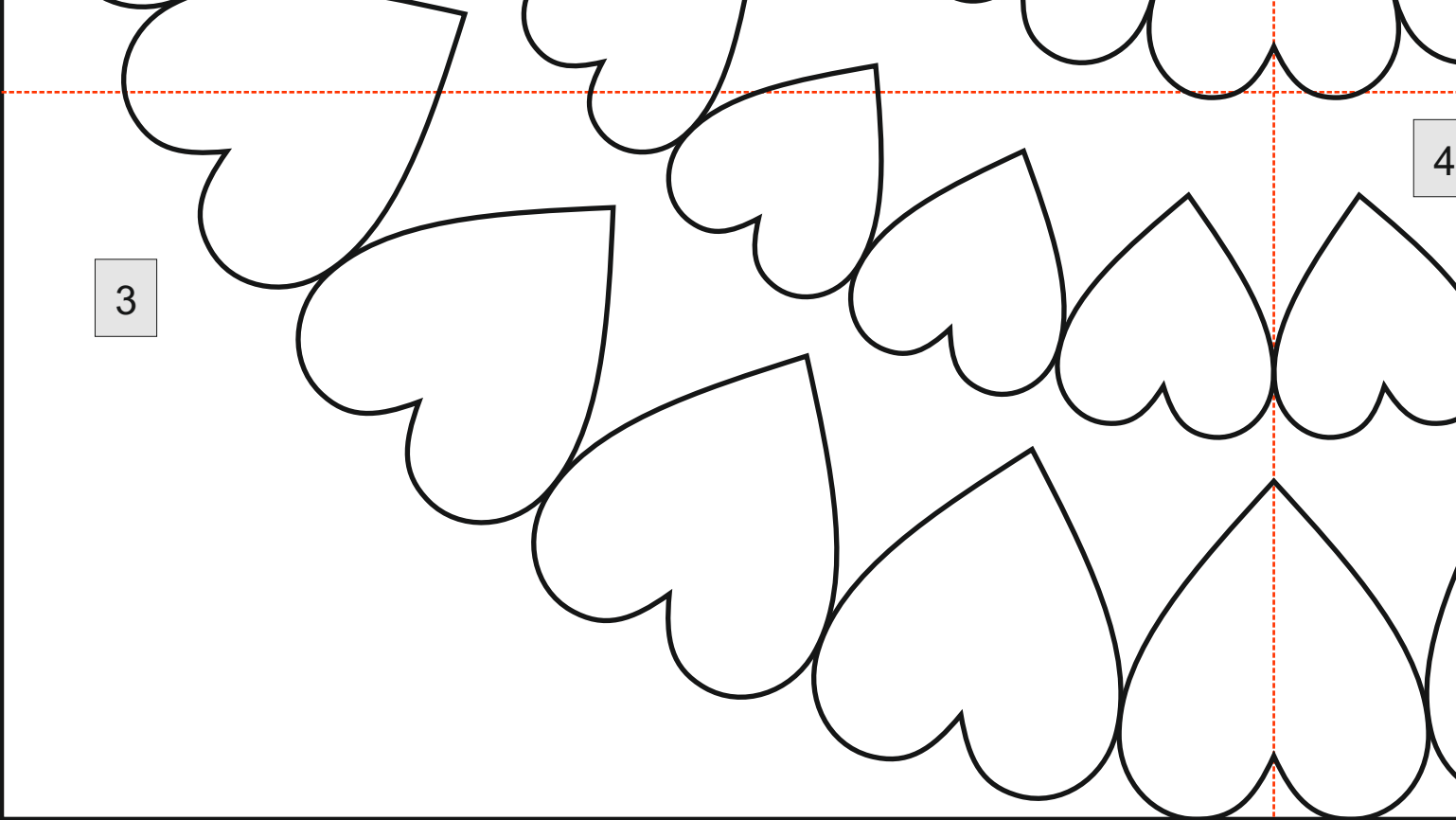

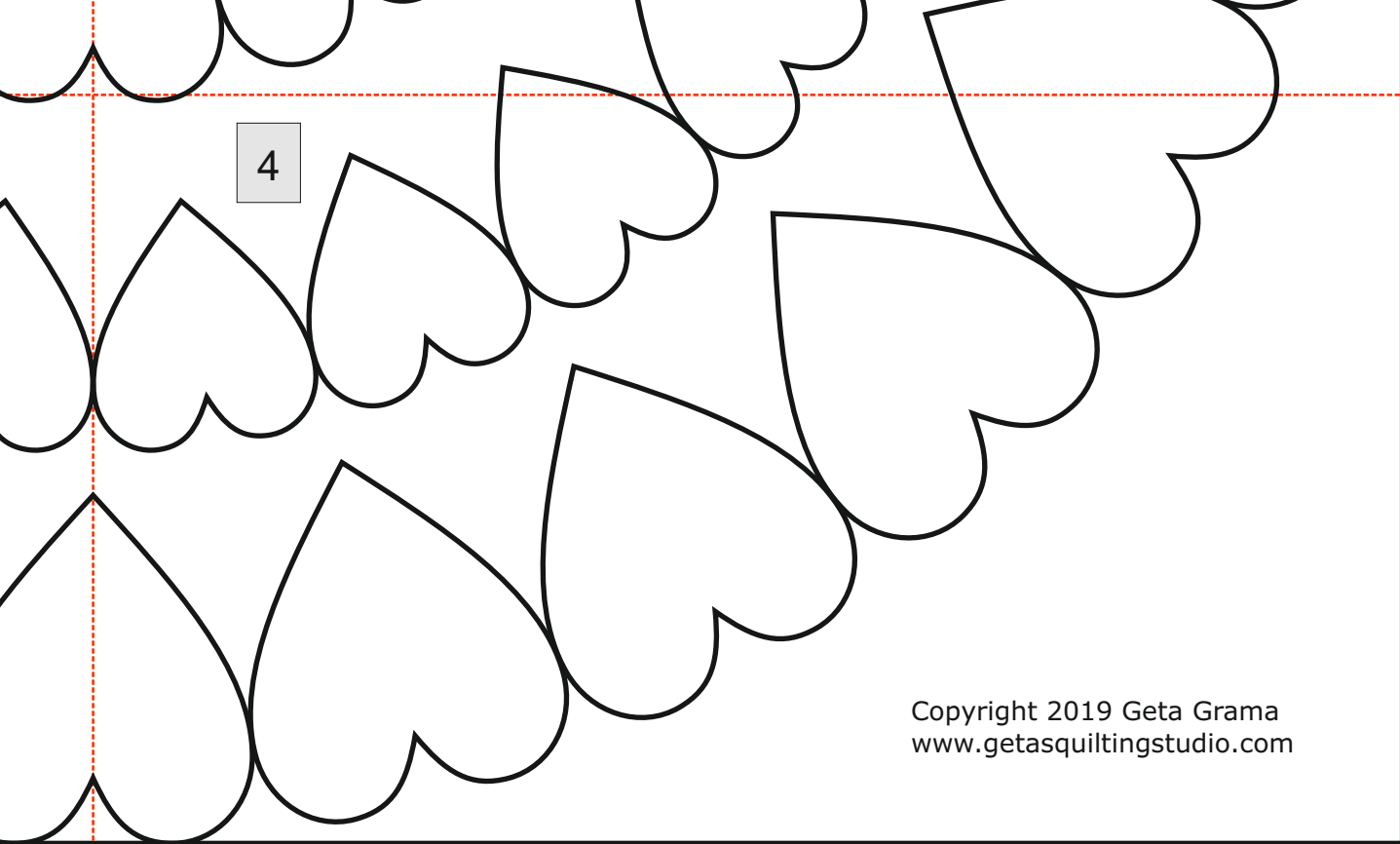
